What are the different types of sills?



Traditional Sills (Inswing)

A traditional sill uses a wood substrate. There are several styles of traditional sill which include all wood or wood components with an aluminum deck. Currently, BetterDoor does not offer a traditional sill system, but replacement caps are available <u>in oak</u> and <u>in vinyl</u>.




Adjustable Sills (Inswing)

An adjustable sill has adjustment screws in the cap piece to allow adjustment at different points to seal against any drafts, leaks and insects. These are sold by BetterDoor in an all-aluminum style and a synthetic composite style.



Articulating Sills (Inswing)

An articulating sill has a spring-loaded articulating cap, which self-adjusts to automatically protect against any drafts, leaks and insects on its own. These are sold by BetterDoor in an <u>all-aluminum style</u> and a <u>synthetic component style</u>.



Bumper Sills (Outswing)

A bumper sill has a piece of weatherstrip inserted into the cap to create a tighter seal against the door panel in an outswing door system. BetterDoor carries the **Z-Series** Bumper Outswing Sill.
